Covid-19 Safety Protocol



Prevent Covid-19

We ask that you or your child not visit Mossom Creek Education Centre or participate in any programs if you are sick. Please stay home if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms: fever, sore throat, cough, headache, runny nose, loss of taste, and/or loss of smell.



Camp Pre-Check

Anyone arriving at Mossom Creek that will be spending time on site is required to complete a quick pre-check to confirm that they are not showing symptoms of Covid-19.



Social Distancing

Please maintain a 2 arms-lengths (2 metres) distance from others. While we will remind all campers on site of social distancing rules, we won't enforce these measures. We do ask that you make your child aware of this rule and that they do their best to leave space between anyone else while indoors and outdoors.



Handwashing

Our program staff and campers are required to frequently wash their hands during their time at Mossom. Each of our program staff also has hand sanitizer on hand for use when a hand washing station isn't available.



Enhanced Cleaning Measures

The Mossom Creek Hatchery and Education Centre is observing elevated cleaning and sanitizing protocols that meet or exceed public health guidelines. Surfaces and equipment are sanitized between camp visits and we provide each camper with sanitized equipment to use during their week at camp.
